## Political Notes

- In 2013, the NC Center for Public Policy Research rated Rep. Jordan the 33<sup>rd</sup> most effective House member in the 120-member body and the 10th most effective House member of those currently serving their second term or less. In 2015, his rating improved to 29. (2017 data is not available.)
- For nearly all of his career, Rep. Jordan has been endorsed by groups as varied as the NRA (Rated A) and Grassroots NC (4-star Recommendation); the State Employees Association EMPAC; the NC Police Benevolent Association; the National Federation of Independent Businesses (NFIB); and NC Right to Life.
- Rep. Jordan was recognized as a “2013 Legislative Champion” and “2015 Legislative Champion” by Mothers Against Drunk Driving.
- Rep. Jordan was recognized for the fourth year in a row as a member of the highest level of conservative excellence by the American Conservative Union, for his support of the ideals articulated in the US Constitution: limited and transparent government, individual rights, personal responsibility, and traditional cultural values.
